Requirements for paper abstract:

- Report title (Bold);
- Abstract text (250–300 words, single line spacing, centered alignment, 12- point *Times New Roman*);
- Abstract includes the description of paper subject in general terms, a short summary of the paper and 5-7 key words;
- Abstract must be written in two languages: Lithuanian and English (when the paper is in Lithuanian) or Russian and English (when the paper is in Russian) or English and Russian (when the paper is in English) The selection of presentation papers will be made and the conference program will be designed based on the abstracts. Abstracts will be included in the conference publication and the participants will be able to choose the presentation they may wish to listen to.
